Competency is assessed via:

- written quiz questions
- assessment questions
- class participation
- practical application of CPR in a simulated environment (includes responding to simulated scenarios)

All participants deemed competent in CPR are issued a certificate which is valid for 12 months and must be renewed prior to expiring.
