What content does the course cover?

In this training session you will learn how to support clients with urinary catheters and strategies to prevent infections. This includes:

- Indications for catheter insertion
- Types of catheters and associated equipment
- Indwelling (IDC) and supra pubic catheter (SPC) care
- Infection prevention and control
- Practical demonstration of catheter position.
