Who is this course for?

What content does the course cover?

In this training session you will learn how to safely assist clients with prescribed nutrition and medications delivered via a gastrostomy and/or jejunostomy.

This includes:

- The basic anatomy and physiology of the digestive system
- Enteral nutrition, its rationale, and goals
- Your role and responsibilities when supporting clients with enteral (tube) nutrition and feeding
- Common feeding tubes and delivery methods
- Solving potential enteral (tube) feeding problems.

Does the course have prerequisites or specific requirements?

- Infection prevention and control - online
- Disability support workshop 1
