

## Powered mobility: Setting the wheels in motion

**Who is this course for?**

This is mandatory training for Occupational Therapists and Physiotherapists with a current caseload.

**What content does the course cover?**

This training session is based on the latest evidence and covers all aspects of the evaluation process to prescribe powered mobility for paediatric and adult clients with a range of physical disabilities.

**This includes:**

- Understanding how and when to introduce powered mobility
- Being aware of current evidence and current technology
- Completing the evaluation process and select appropriate alternate control devices
- Understanding how to match specific PWC features to suit client needs
- Guiding and supporting skill development and outcome measurement.

**Note:** The focus is on the features and function of the equipment (not specific brands), as product information is covered by suppliers.

**Does the course have prerequisites or specific requirements?**

**The following must be completed before attending:**

- Seating and Positioning - online (or are competent in prescribing seating)
- Pre-reading (will be emailed to participants in advance).

**Note:** You must also have a current caseload which includes at least one client who requires powered mobility.
